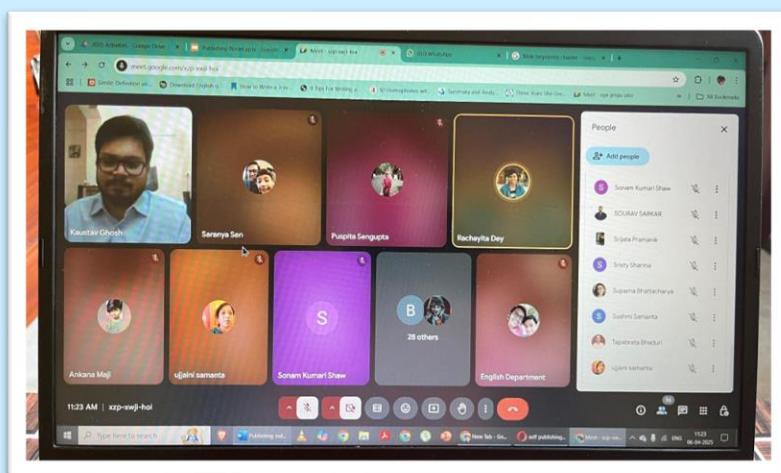
A Step-by-Step Guidance to Conduct Primary Survey

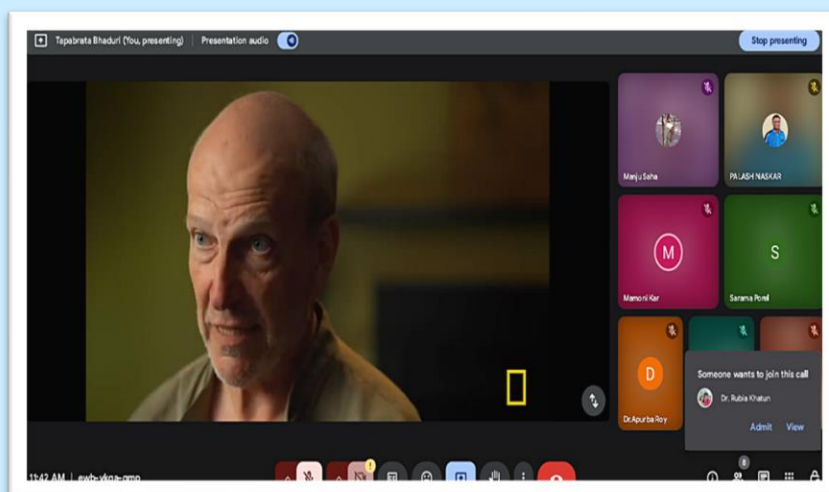
Faculty Exchange Programme: Department of Sanskrit

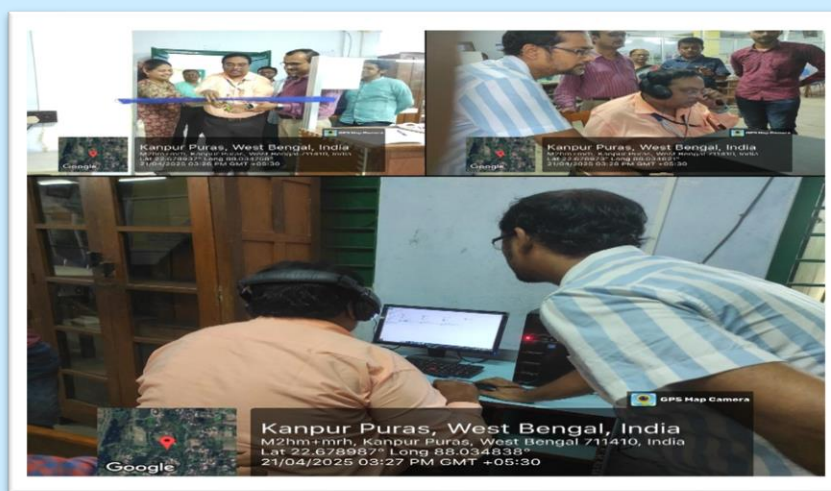
Special Lecture on National Education Policy 2020
